#### CHURCHWARDENS RAMBLINGS

Time for change - in future months you will hear from the new Rector, the Reverend George Frost, in this Newsletter. George arrives in the Rectory on 3rd July and we welcome him into the village and look forward to his Ministry among us. George grew up just north of Northampton in a farming family and was educated at Aberdeen and Durham Universities as he prepared to become our Rector. Although George moves into the Rectory he does not begin work for us until the 23rd July after his Installation Service the evening before in St Michael's Church. #### ABILITY - The Community Mini-Bus Service for all Residents of Aynho

The Ability mini-bus is an invaluable service providing transport and independence to all Aynho residents. There is a **twice weekly mini-bus to Banbury town centre** or various supermarkets on **Tuesday & Thursday** and on **Friday to Brackley** to visit the market & various shops as well as special trips to a variety of locations - **see list below!** 

There is a £10 fee to REGISTER and is FREE to use if you have a valid bus pass and use the village bus stops. There is a fare payable to any non-concessionary bus pass holders.

A door-to-door service is also available for a small annual fee.

You need to **REGISTER** with the scheme before you can use the service.
