# For your information A Rough Guide to the PCC Parochial Church Council

The PCC looks after the general running of the Church and oversees the finances of the same by law.

The PCC consists of various members; the Rector; 6 or 9 elected PCC members, plus exoficio member, namely the Churchwardens; Deanery Synod Representatives, and the nominated officers being the PCC secretary and the PCC treasurer. All Parochial Church Councillors are elected to and serve for a maximum period of three consecutive years, after which they are required to stand down before seeking re-election. It is ideal if 1/3 of the PCC's members are elected each year.

Any member of the church can stand for election onto the PCC as long as they have registered to be on the Church Electoral Role and are over 18 years of age. You should find a list of your local PCC members displayed in your church with a list of members on the church Electoral role.
