<u>Church Membership &</u> <u>Electoral Roll</u>

The Church of England is a legal body covered by The Church representation rules. This means that the church has a membership list that allows the members to vote on political and religious matter within the church structure.

Official membership has no cost, but the applicant must be:-

- baptised
- over 16 years of age
- must not be ordained

 And must be one of the following

 a- resident in the parish

 b- habitually attend the parish

 church for at least six months

 c- Be a member of a church in good

 standing with the CofE and have

 habitually attended public worship in

 the parish during the period of six

 months prior to enrolment.

The Churches' Electoral Roll is much more than a list of names, it is also a means of communicating with the whole church body in any village. Once in every six years the preparation of new church electoral rolls takes place, which means that everyone must come off the roll and re-apply and as 2025 is that year everyone who is currently on the electoral register needs to fill in an application form.

We also welcome any new qualifying person to apply for registration. We would ask that if you come to church and can fulfil the above requirements that you please complete an application form that will be found in church in the coming weeks, If you cannot fulfil the above requirements it doesn't mean you are not welcome, for all are welcome.
